Public schools generally prefer and usually hire only native English speakers to teach English. Teaching aspirants need not require speaking Korean but preference is given to those with a Bachelor's degree and a TEFL certificate.

### **Salary and Benefits**

The TEFL industry in South Korea is quite big and a great deal of importance is given to English education in the South Korean public and private school systems. A lot of foreign EFL/ESL teachers come to Korea under the auspices of the government-run program for English instruction in public schools called EPIK.

South Korea offers a plethora of opportunities when it comes to English teachers and there is a large community of foreign teachers in Korea from countries like USA and UK. The pay scale is extremely good in South Korea and if anyone goes for a one year contract he/she will get a free accommodation, airfare and all the necessary facilities.

#### Salary structure of an EFL/ESL teacher in South Korea varies from school to school:

- Average teacher salary at a Korean Hagwon or private academy ranges from 1.9 to 2.1 million won or 1,600 USD - 1,900 USD per month
- EFL/ESL teacher salaries at a public school range from 1.5 - 3 million won or 1,265 USD to 2,500 USD per month
- International schools pay between 1.8 2.9 million won or 1,600 USD 2,700 USD to an EFL/ESL teacher

In Seoul you will find lots of teaching English jobs and there is sizable chunk of EFL/ESL teachers working in the Korean capital.
